RULES & REGULATIONS

A \$1,000 deposit or full payment is due upon receipt of your application. THIS DEPOSIT WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. Full payment is due on March 7, 2025. Applications received after March 7, 2025, must be paid in full.

Cancellations: ISC must receive written notification of a space cancellation on or before March 14, 2025. A \$1,000 service charge will be assessed for each canceled space. No refunds will be given after March 1, 2024.

Failure to Occupy Space—The exhibitor will forfeit any space not occupied by 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 5, 2025. ISC may reassign or use this space without a refund unless ISC approves arrangements for delayed occupancy.

Force Majeure - The performance of this Agreement by either party is subject to acts of God, war, government regulation, disaster, fire, epidemic, threatened or imminent strikes, civil disorder, curtailment of transportation facilities, threats or terrorist attacks, or other similar occurrence beyond the control of the parties, making it illegal, impossible, or commercially impractical to carry on the Exhibits or fully perform the terms of this Agreement. This Agreement may be terminated, or performance may be excused without penalty for any of such reasons by written notice from one party to the other.

Catastrophe - In the event of fire, strikes, or another unavoidable occurrence rendering the exhibit space unfit for use, provisions will be made for the exhibit elsewhere, or a proper financial adjustment will be made to the exhibitor.
